AUTONOMÍA PARA LA INDUSTRIA MINERA EN EL MANEJO Y RECICLAJE DE NEUMÁTICOS FUERA DE USO (NFU)



Problema que resuelve: Soluciona la recuperación de un porcentaje importante de los neumáticos fuera de uso (NFU) y se alinea con las metas y exigencias de la nueva ley REP N°20.920.

Descripción de la innovación: Busca reducir el descomulgamiento generalizado de los fondos del caucho reciclado de los neumáticos, evitar la contaminación de que este es un producto potencialmente atractivo para nuevos negocios generando una economía circular.

Ventajas: Dentro de los innumerables ventajas de este proyecto son: - Ahorrar energía, materias primas y emisiones de CO2 al medio ambiente. - Contribuir a la conservación de los Bosques. - Fabricar nuevos productos ecológicos. - Crear empleo verde y fomentar la economía circular.

OJO DE LINCE



Problema que resuelve: No define las nuevas zonas de contacto post tronadura genera mayores costos de producción debido a la dilución de mineral, en embargo el problema más evidente es la pérdida de mineral entre su contacto el material que contiene ley se desliza a zonas de tierra y se desliza, aquí es donde se aplica "Ojo de Lince" otorga el mayor beneficio y se aplica a todas las empresas mineras de la región y gran impacto ambiental a corto plazo.

Descripción de la innovación: Ojo de Lince es un método patentado de monitoreo y análisis del desplazamiento de rocas a causa de las tronaduras, por medio de la formación de video desde una serie de cámaras, creando un modelo a partir de varias imágenes superpuestas que se producen de las máquinas tronadoras de zonas de mineral previamente identificadas en contacto LinceMineral, obteniendo la dirección efectiva del desplazamiento de los bloques fragmentados y conociendo las nuevas áreas de contacto LinceMineral, utilizando la tecnología de imágenes aéreas mediante aerofotogrametría a partir de drones del tipo UAV. Ventajas: Ojo de Lince optimiza el proceso de tronadura y recupera hasta un 10% de pérdida de mineral tronado, reduce el vector de desechos de mineral por aumento de volúmenes en tiempo real y obtiene el movimiento de la tronadura de forma remota, disminuyendo la exposición del personal al momento de la tronadura, y alto nivel de seguridad y menor del reducción tiempo de trabajo y costos generados por la rotación de rocas.

DRAGAS A CONTROL REMOTO PARA MINERÍA



Problema que resuelve: Recuperación de relaves en zonas y demás zonas de captación de sólidos sin necesidad de operadores a bordo.

Descripción de la innovación: Dragas electrónicas operadas a través de control remoto y de dimensiones compactas para su uso en espacios de relaves, embalses de agua y grutas y otras zonas donde se acumulan sólidos.

Ventajas: No se requieren operadores a bordo por lo que la operación es completamente segura. Las dimensiones compactas del sistema permiten una fácil y rápida instalación, permitiendo maximizar la capacidad de almacenamiento de los presas por un costo inferior, eliminando el riesgo para los operadores.

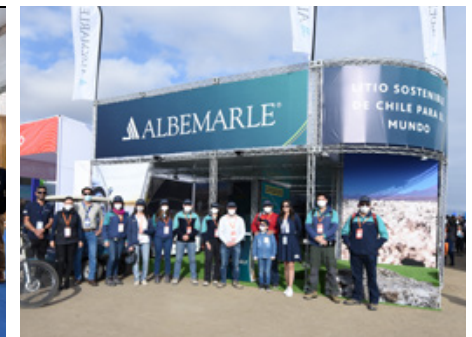
