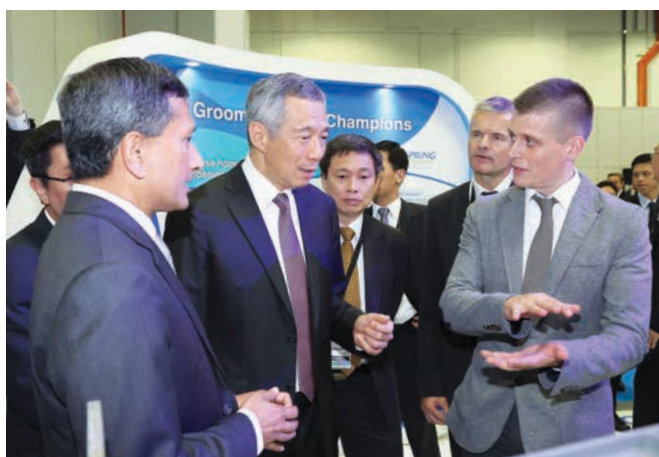

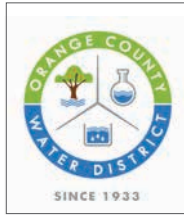

The prestigious **Lee Kuan Yew Water Prize** recognises and honours outstanding contributions by individuals and organisations towards applying innovative technologies, policies or programmes to water challenges in the world.

This international award is named after Singapore's first Prime Minister Lee Kuan Yew, whose foresight and leadership has enabled Singapore to attain a sustainable water supply.

Since its inception in 2008, the **Lee Kuan Yew Water Prize** has gained a standing in the global water arena as the premier Water Prize focused on real-world application. The honour roll commemorates laureates for groundbreaking solutions in membrane technology, used water treatment and holistic water policies and management which have improved the lives of millions.

The **Lee Kuan Yew Water Prize 2016** laureate will receive S\$300,000, a certificate and a gold medallion at the award ceremony held at SIWW 2016.

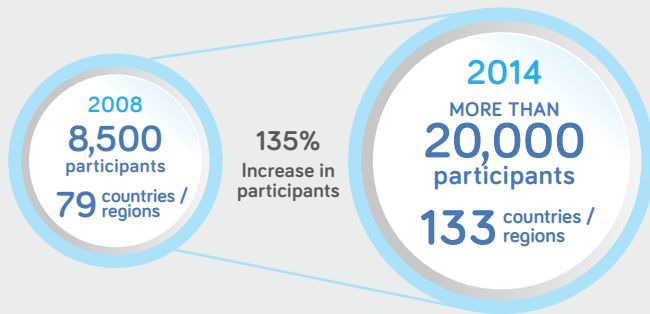

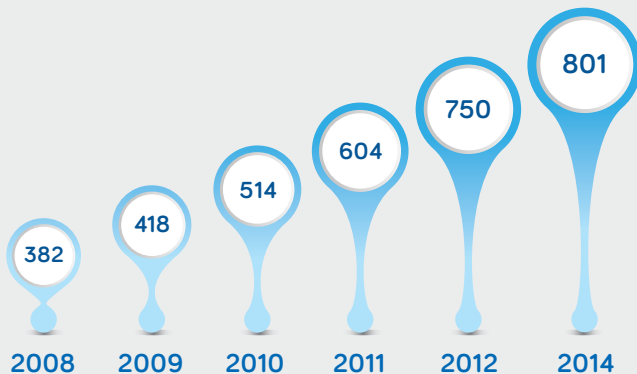

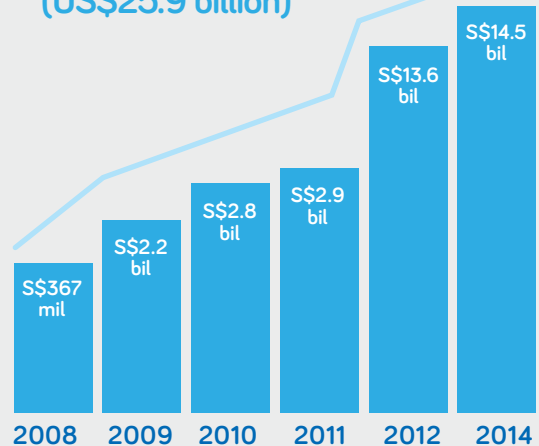
